

Esti Service Contraindications

HYDRAFACIAL:

Postpone if:

Do not perform if:

- Open wound/broken skin
- Active infection
- Cold sores/herpes outbreak (unless medicated)
- Severe inflammatory acne
- Active rash or significant skin irritation
- Unidentified/suspicious skin lesions/growths
- Severe sunburn
- Known allergy to ingredient
- Certain autoimmune/communicable diseases

- **Botox** : about 1 week
- **Dermal filler** : about 2 weeks
- **Laser treatment** : about 3-4 weeks or until fully healed
- **Medical Grade Chemical Peel** : about 3-4 weeks or until healed
- **Waxing** : several days
- **Isotretinoin/Accutane** : 1 year after last use

Use caution:

- Retinoids/tretinoin and strong exfoliating acids
- Blood thinner/anticoagulants
- Topical steroids
- Antibiotics
- Autoimmune conditions
- Rosacea/very sensitive skin
- History of cold sores
- Allergies to acids/serum/booster
- Any recent cosmetic procedure

MICRONEEDLING:

Postpone if:

Do not perform if:

- Active acne
- Active infection
- Active cold sore/herpes outbreak
- Open wounds, cuts, abrasions, broken skin
- Moderate/Severe dermatitis, eczema, psoriasis, or active rosacea flare
- Severe sunburn, or recent sunburn
- Poor wound healing
- History of keloids or problematic hypertrophic scarring
- Known allergy to products or anesthetics used
- Suspicious/unexplained lesions in treatment area
- Active skin cancer

- **Botox** : about 1 week
- **Dermal filler** : about 2 weeks
- **Laser treatment** : about 3-4 weeks or until fully healed
- **Medical Grade Chemical Peel** : about 3-4 weeks or until healed
- **Waxing** : several days
- **Recent tanning/sun exposure** : wait until skin is healed
- **Isotretinoin/Accutane** : 1 year after last use

Use caution:

- Accutane/Isotretinoin use
- Blood thinners/anticoagulants
- Immunosuppressive medications
- Medications that impair wound healing
- Uncontrolled diabetes
- Active chemotherapy/radiation
- Bleeding/clotting disorders
- Immune deficiency

Esti Service Contraindications

GLY PRO POWER PEEL + / TRIPLE TRANSFORMATION PEEL

Do not perform/Postpone:

- Active cold sore/herpes outbreak
- Open wounds, cuts, abrasions or compromised skin
- Active skin infection
- Significant dermatitis, eczema, psoriasis or an active rosacea flare
- Moderate/severe sunburn
- Known allergy/sensitivity to any peel ingredients
- Significant unexplained skin irritation
- Poor wound healing or a history of problematic scarring
- Recent excessive sun exposure/tanning

Wait time before peel:

- **Waxing** : 3-5 days
- **Botox** : 1 week
- **Dermal filler** : 2 weeks
- **Microblading** : 3-4 weeks
- **IPL** : 2-4 weeks
- **Laser Resurfacing** : 3-6 months
- **Prescription Retin-A/Retinoic acid** : 3 months
- **Accutane/Isotretinoin** : 1 year
- **Significant sun exposure** : 2 weeks
